

**AMERICAN BAPTIST WOMEN'S MINISTRIES
OF LOS ANGELES AND CONGREGATIONS OF THE SOUTHWEST AND HAWAII**

U.S. SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a scholarship, the applicant must:

1. Be a Christian.
2. Be an active member of an American Baptist Church of Los Angeles or the Congregations of the Southwest and Hawaii for at least twelve months prior to application.
 - a. be from a Baptist mission field, studying in our country or her homeland, recommended by the mission contact person, or
 - b. be a daughter of missionaries on national or international fields whose memberships are still held in AB churches in this region.
3. Be planning to enter a church-related vocation, or have a sense of Christian mission in another vocation.
4. Be at least a high school senior.
5. Show you have a financial need.
6. Have a scholastic record of 3.00 grade average or better, and have been accepted for college entrance.
7. Apply as a regular full-time student planning on attending a fully accredited school of higher education. The school must qualify under the following guides (subject to approval by the Scholarship Committee):
 - a. an American Baptist related school;
 - b. a school where there is an American Baptist ministry available to the student;
 - c. a state school of higher education within the region;
 - d. schools of other denominations but are consistent with Baptist belief
8. Be willing to sign the agreement stated on the application form regarding the Scholarship Aid.

(Applicants from outside the United States are not always able to fulfill all the requirements and will be considered with the understanding and knowledge of that particular area.)
